Aims and scope

The conference is open to academic research in all areas of accounting, including auditing, financial reporting & analysis, management accounting and control and sustainability reporting. We especially welcome contributions from PhD students and junior faculty.

Submission guidelines and deadlines

Authors can submit their full-length papers in electronic format to www.ieseg-ard-2025.sciencesconf.org to be considered for presentation. Only papers written in English will be considered. The deadline for **submission** of papers is February 1, 2025. Authors will be notified of acceptance by mid-February 2025.

Registration

The research day **registration fee of €75** includes a light breakfast, coffee breaks, and lunch. Attendees that may wish to stay overnight in Lille - the night before the conference - are welcome to attend an early bird **dinner** at a local restaurant in Vieux Lille.
